If you are new to Verizon, you'll need to register and install your High Speed Internet or FiOS Internet before you can access the Verizon Wi-Fi service.

- Confirm that you have a required operating system. Verizon Wi-Fi Connect is compatible with 32-bit versions of Windows XP and 32-bit and 64-bit versions of Windows Vista. Service Pack 3 is required for use with Windows XP.
- Verizon Wi-Fi is not available for PDAs, phones, desktop PCs or Macs.

Registering for Verizon Wi-Fi is quick and easy!

- Sign in at business.verizon.net.
- Click on "My Account" and look for the Verizon Wi-Fi link.
- Select "Verizon Wi-Fi Registration" and follow the prompts to create your Wi-Fi username and password. Only primary Verizon Internet account holders can add a Wi-Fi account.
- You will then be guided to download Verizon Wi-Fi Connect that allows you to sign on at eligible hot spots.
- After your download is complete, you'll see a Verizon Wi-Fi Connect icon in your Windows task bar.

One Website Does It All!

Go to business.verizon.net/myaccount to create a Verizon Wi-Fi username, download Verizon Wi-Fi Connect software to multiple computers, search for hotspots near you, or find additional information. Once you've installed the Verizon Wi-Fi Connect software, you can also click on the Verizon Wi-Fi icon located on your laptop to search for hotspots nationwide. The Verizon Wi-Fi Hotspot Directory is downloaded with your Wi-Fi Connect software so you can look for hotspots without being connected to the Internet.

Whenever you're within a Verizon hotspot, the Verizon Wi-Fi Connect icon in your task bar will alert you with a pop-up screen and you can sign in and connect. Just enter your Verizon Wi-Fi username and password to log in, open a browser and start surfing!
