Verizon offers long distance with one low, flat rate per minute! Now you can have competitive, flat rates, coordinated customer service, and one point of contact for your business communications needs.

SimpleOptions Calling Plan 4.4¢ or less per minute for state-to-state calls

Review your monthly long distance billing, and if your business spends \$3,000 per month or more, you may benefit from the SimpleOptions Calling Plan, which provides lower direct-dialed rates for high volume users.

Sign up for a one- or three-year term agreement and receive discounts of the standard per-minute state-to-state SimpleOptions rate.

With our SimpleOptions Calling Plan, you will enjoy:

- A rate of 4.4¢ or less per minute for direct-dialed state-to-state calls
- Competitive, per-minute rates for direct-dialed in-state long distance calls (Please contact a Verizon account representative for the rates.)
- Calls rated in 6-second increments with an 18-second minimum
- All long distance usage contributing towards the minimum spending level you select

You also get the same low per-minute rate for all your state-to-state inbound toll free calls. And if you're switching from another carrier, you can keep your current toll free number.

You will be charged an early termination fee if you cancel your SimpleOptions Calling Plan before the end of the agreed-upon term. This early termination charge is 35% of your minimum spending level commitment multiplied by the number of months remaining in the term of the agreement.

You will also be charged your minimum spending level commitment even if your long distance usage is less than this commitment. SimpleOptions Calling Plan customers can reduce their minimum spending commitment by one level, once in a bill cycle, without incurring a penalty.

Calling card calls carried and billed by Verizon are just 36¢ a minute. Calling card calls are 34¢ with the 1-year term plan and 31¢ with the 3-year term plan. The Verizon long distance calling card is available to businesses that choose Verizon for their long distance service.²

- A single bill for your local and long distance charges when your local services are provided by a Verizon local carrier

Charges imposed by other Verizon affiliates, including your local Verizon telephone company, do not contribute to the MSL. Charges such as taxes, Universal Service Fund (USF) surcharges, presubscribed interexchange carrier charges, payphone charges, early termination charges, non-recurring charges and calling card usage (carried by a carrier other than VES) also do not contribute to the MSL.

² Verizon Calling Card calls originated in an area where Verizon is not authorized to offer long distance service will be carried and rated by another carrier and will not contribute to your minimum spending level. These calls may also include surcharges.
